Browett Road	Three Spires Avenue	Cross freely until 09:45 No crossing from 09:50 – 10:45 Cross under marshal supervision and when safe to do so from 10:50 – 12:15 Use Max Road, Browett Road and Redesdale Avenue onto Holyhead Road from 11:00 for access and egress as normal or use crossing point if coming from Radford Road

Southbank Road	Scots Lane	Cross freely until 09:45 No crossing from 09:50 – 10:45 Cross under marshal supervision and when safe to do so from 10:50 – 12:15

- ❖ Access maintained southbound along Tamworth Road and Radford Road towards the city centre throughout the road closures. Radford Road towards the city centre will be possible via Sandy Lane from Lydgate Lane onto Light Lane
- ❖ Access maintained along Holyhead Road westbound throughout the road closures
