

Leeds Half Marathon Road Closure – Advisory Information Sunday 8th May 2022

General Information – Allow extra time for all journeys

- The race route is shown as the orange line on the image below and is fully closed.

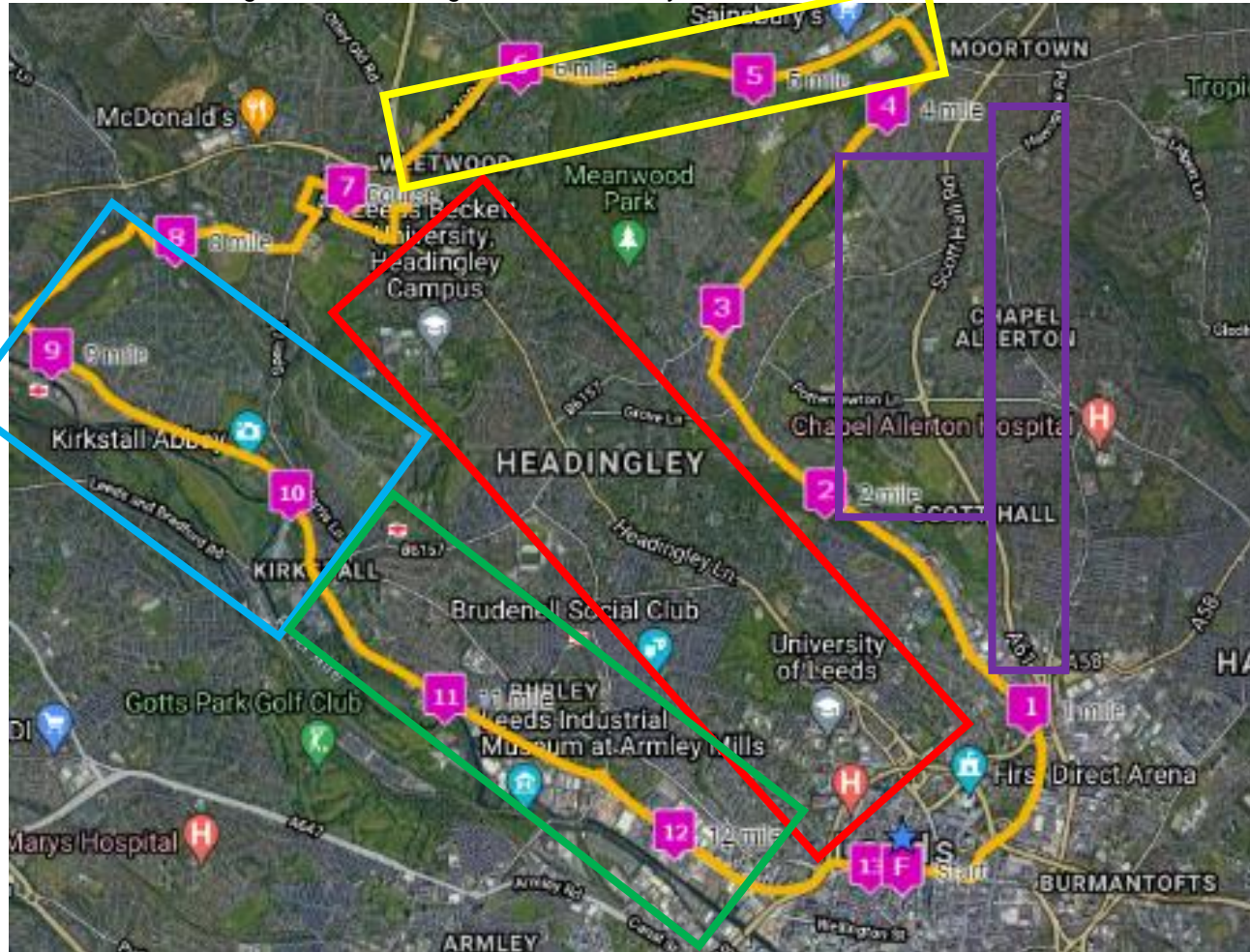
Abbey Road/Kirkstall Road Closed – Diversion via A657/Stanningley Road/Armley Road - Use Scott Hall Road diversion to travel northbound/southbound or A6120 Eastbound

Access to Headingley via Inner Ring Road > Blenheim Terrace > Woodhouse Lane until 13:00

Access/Egress to Hawksworth using Kirkstall Hill > Burley Road > Inner Ring Road (Or in reverse) (Follow Scott Hall Road Diversion or Armley Road diversion)

Access to Kirkstall Forge Train Station from Savins Mill Way – Access lane maintained along Abbey Road

Whole of Kirkstall Road closed from 08:30 to 13:15. Access via Burley Road and Inner Ring Road maintained throughout or diversion via A657/Stanningley Road/Armley Road



Access Eastbound on Ring Road (A6120) maintained throughout event and one lane of westbound carriageway will be open

Headingley/Otley Road Diversion onto Inner Ring Road and use diversion via Scott Hall Road or Armley Road - No access to A6120 from 08:30 - 13:00

Use Inner Ring onto Blenheim Terrace > Woodhouse Lane for access to Headingley from 08:30 to 13:00

Diversion using Scott Hall Road to travel northbound/southbound and avoid closures around Meanwood Road.

Access lane maintained along A6120 to travel westbound from Moor Allerton (Eastbound travel maintained throughout)

Access to Headingley via Inner Ring Road > Blenheim Terrace > Woodhouse Lane from 08:30 until 13:00
