Thank you for entering the Arena Group Sheffield Mini and Junior Race! We hope you and your family are excited about being part of this fantastic event and that you're looking forward to joining the other families on the day.

The race office is located in Tudor Square and will be open between 12pm and 3pm on Saturday 22nd September and from 10am on Sunday 23rd September. Please visit the race office to collect your race number.

RACE INFORMATION

Runners should arrive ready to run as there is no baggage store for the Mini and Junior Race.

All runners are required to assemble on Arundel Gate at 11.30am for a warm up for the whole family before being led to the start of the race.

The Mini and Junior Race will start at 11.45am.

Remember to pace yourself and take it steady, particularly at the start, as there will be lots of runners taking part. Please be considerate of other runners at all times.
