

Sheffield Half Marathon – Sunday 7th April 2024

Road Closure – Advisory Information

General Information – Allow extra time for all journeys

- The race route is shown as the red line/blue line on the image below and is fully closed.
- Traffic travelling up Dore Road can access High Street but there is no access from High Street to Dore Road
- A621 Abbeydale Road and A57 Manchester Road will remain open throughout the event as the main alternatives for A625 Ecclesall Road / Ecclesall Road South
- Ring Road closed at junction with A625 Ecclesall Road (no access between A57 Manchester Road and A621 Bramall Lane)
- Crossing points at Bents Road, Haugh Lane, Harley Road, Parkhead Road and Croft Lane will be maintained throughout the event and facilitated when safe to do so

For City Centre, North, East & South: A57 Manchester Road (eastbound) > A61 Ring Road (eastbound)

For West: A57 Manchester Road (westbound)

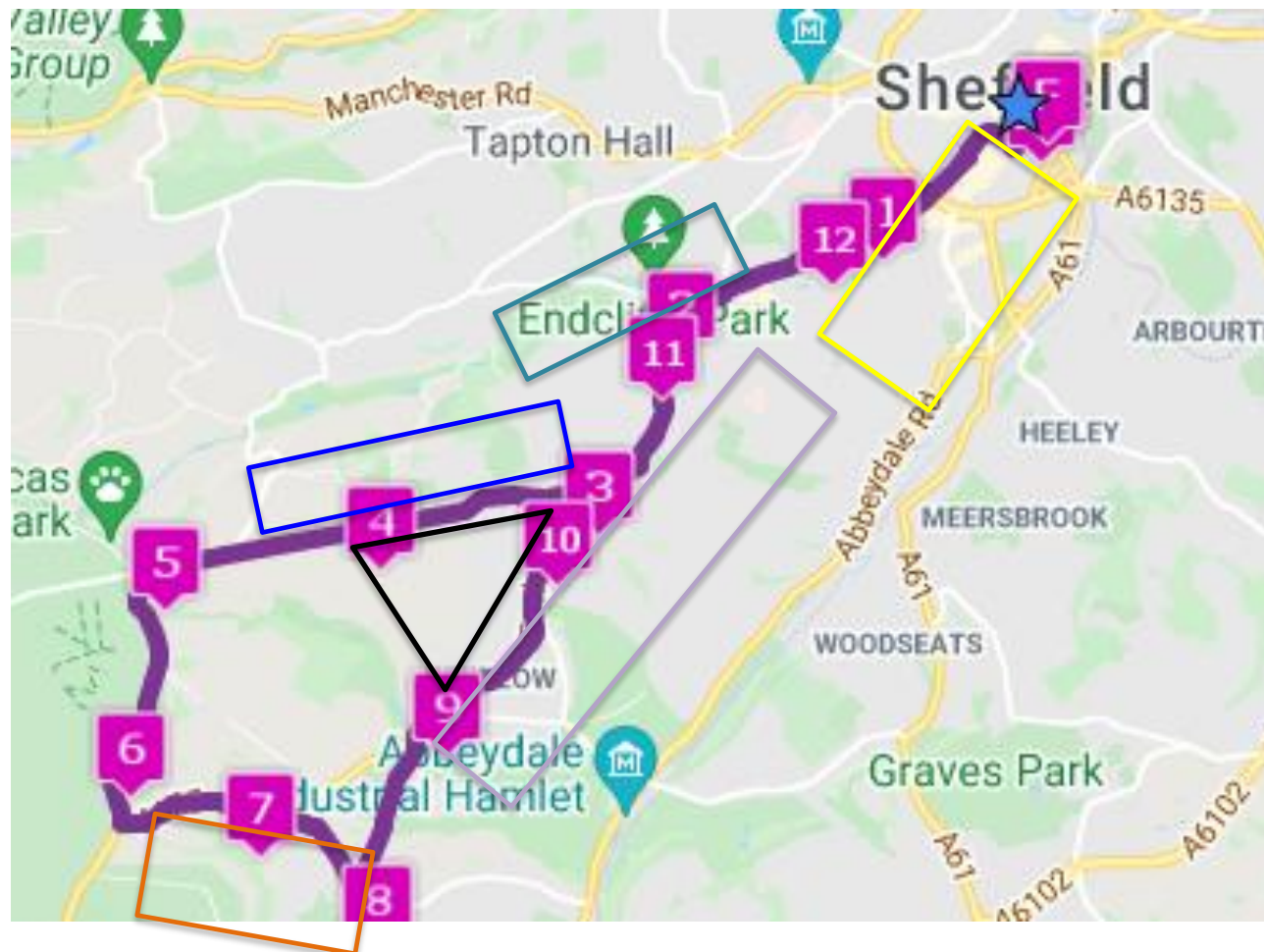
For City Centre, North, East & South: Fulwood Road > A57 Manchester Road > A61 Ring Road (eastbound)

For West: Fulwood Road > Crimicar Lane > Redmires Road > Lodge Lane > A57 Manchester Road (westbound)

For City Centre, North & East: A621 Abbeydale Road South > A621 Bramall Lane > A61 Ring Road (eastbound)

For West: A621 Abbeydale Road South (southbound) > B6054

For South: A621 Abbeydale Road South (southbound)



For South: A61 Ring Road in clockwise direction (open to B6388 London Road)

For North & West: A61 Ring Road in anticlockwise direction (open to A57 Western Bank)

For City Centre: A621 Abbeydale Road South > A621 Bramall Lane

For all other directions: A621 Abbeydale Road South > A61 Queens Road > A61 Ring Road in anticlockwise direction (open to A57 Western Bank)

Please use crossing points at Bents Road, Haugh Lane or Harley Road during the road closures. These will be maintained when safe to do so.
